## SANGIOVESE

COSI BELLA VINEYARD | LODI

### 2014 VINTAGE NOTES:

Now after working with the Cosi Bella vineyard for a couple of years, I found that there is a “sweet spot” in the sugar levels for the field, pick too early and the wine is tight and rigid, too late and you lose some of the delicate aromatics. So for 2014 I decided to pull back and pick just a bit earlier than our usual. The resulting wine is beautiful with a big, plush texture and loads of lovely fruit on the nose. As many of you know, this is consistently one of my favorite wines in the cellar and its because of its versatility with food. Do yourself a favor, fire up the grill, pop the Sangiovese and have a great summer meal.

### TASTING NOTES:

Dark brick red in the glass, on the nose the wine is loaded with ripe strawberry-cranberry preserves, lingering in red cherry and mild leather and char. After opening in the glass, soft aromas of custard and vanilla spice round it out. On your first sip, broad, bold tannins tussle with bold fruit, laying down softly in sweet spice and soft smokey notes of coffee & spice.
