NOMA VINEYARD | LODI APPELLATION

VINTAGE NOTES:

One of four original 1978 trial plantings of Barbera in the Lodi appellation, this field has become one of our favorites to work with. It sits in deep sandy soil in the south section of Lodi that requires a deft hand to maintain good water balance yet yields consistently ripe balanced fruit year after year. Due to the older vines, ripening takes longer and therefore develops more complex aromatic and tannin structures than younger plantings.

The 2019 release was aged in a mix of French and American oak for 22 months. Generally a riper vintage than 2018 the wine comes across bolder and more extracted overall.

TASTING NOTES:

Dark and brooding with luxurious layers of ripe black cherry, plum and cedar all accented with soft sweet vanilla char, lingering on the palate with fat rich tannins.
